STAY:

We offer a range of options for camping and accommodation,

CABINS:

LIONS LODGE:

A self contained lodge with
12 bunks in two rooms. It is
specifically designed for
people with special needs. It
includes a small lounge,
kitchen, bathroom & shower.
There is grass outside for
camping and mattresses for
up to 12 extra people.

OLD ROVERS LODGE:

Usually booked in
association with Fletcher
Hall, this lodge sleeps 12
with fridge & hot water
facilities. It can be leased
seperately where possible.
