Adventure Activities

CastleRock specialises in providing adventure activity programmes that work with EOTC requirements at primary, intermediate, secondary and tertiary levels. Programmes provide students with opportunities to learn and use skills to overcome challenges set before them - at the same time experiencing an awesome adventure.

Single or multi day programmes are tailored to suit age, timeframes and objectives set out by the school.

On site activities include; rock climbing; abseiling; a 280 metre flying fox; mountain biking; archery and orienteering.

Off site activities include; kayaking; Maungatautari Ecological Island; and caving.

Accommodation

The Woolshed sleeps 19, marae style with mattresses on the floor. Fully equipped basic kitchen and shower and toilet. Camping available for group overflow.

The CastleRock Lodge a beautifully renovated homestead with magnificent views of the CastleRock climbing crag sleeps up to 24 with a fully equipped kitchen. Large decks lead to a solar heated pool, spa, BBQ area and tennis court.
